SUBJECT:- Grant of ex-gratia payment for Casual Paid Labourers working in BRO.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for grant of ex-gratia lumpsum compensation payable to the NOKs of Casual Paid Labourers who die as a result of accident / acts of violence by terrorists, naxalities, insurgents, anti social elements or are disabled due to an accident at the work site / acts of violence by terrorists, naxalities, insurgents and anti social elements while performing their duty during their engagement on muster roll. Casual Paid Labourers who have worked at least for a total of 179 days in the service of BRO as on the date of the accident leading to death / disablement of CPL, will be entitled for payment of ex-gratia grant under this scheme.

2. Ex-gratia lump sum compensation will be paid to the labourers on sustaining any injury or death after finalisation of the Inquiry: The Inquiry Committee will consist of three officers namely Accounts Officer, Medical Officer and I/C RCC and will recommend the category in the scheme under which the amount of compensation can be paid to the NoK of CPL. Claims shall be processed alongwith supporting documents like FIR, Post Mortem Report, Death Certificate (in case of death), Medical documents, if any, Part II Orders notifying the death / injury casualty, recommendation of Officer Commanding RCC, Task Force Commander, Committee and Chief Engineer (Project). The details / modalities are given in SOP enclosed as Appendix-'A'.

3. The rates of ex-gratia in case of death or injury are as under:-

(A) **IN THE CASE OF DEATH**

- Rs.2.00 lakh

Death occurring due to accident in the course of performance of duties or attributable to acts of violence by terrorists, naxalities, insurgents, anti social elements etc. in course of performance of duties or death while performing his duty during his engagement on muster roll.

- (B) IN THE CASE OF PERMANENT DISABLEMENT
Permanent total disablement (100% disability) - Rs.1.50 lakh
- (C) IN THE CASE OF PARTIAL DISABLEMENT - Rs.1.00lakh x %age
of loss of earning
capacity as per
Annexure-I to
Appendix - 'A' or as
assessed by the
competent medical
authority wherever
not listed.

4. Claims should be submitted duly concurred by AO / ACDA concerned.
5. Director General Border Roads will be the sanctioning authority for payment of ex-gratia grant under this scheme. These powers will be exercised in consultation with IFA/BR.
6. The payment will be made through District Administration of the concerned District.
7. The expenditure involved will be debitable to Major Head / Job under which the affected CPL was working.
8. The above payment will be made in addition to the Workmen's Compensation as applicable as per Workmen Compensation Act, 1923.
9. No compensation is entitled to CPLs on account of death and disability due to acts of suicide.
10. These orders will take effect from the date of issue of this letter.
11. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Defence (Fin/BR) vide their ID No. 19(3) BRS/07/(54/09) dated 14th January, 2009.
