Notification

S.R.O. \_\_\_\_\_.- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Border Roads Development Board, General Reserve Engineer Force (Border Roads Organisation), Group 'C' Posts Recruitment Rules, 2012, namely :-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Defence, Border Roads Organisation, General Reserve Engineer Force, Draughtsman, Group 'C' Posts Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2020.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Border Roads Development Board, General Reserve Engineer Force (Border Roads Organisation), Group 'C' Posts Recruitment Rules, 2012, in Schedule after serial number 13 and the entries relating thereto, the following serial number and entries shall be inserted, namely:-
