Subject: Use of BIMS portal (www.bims.gov.in) for procurement of Highway Contracts on EPC/ HAM/ BOT Mode - regarding.

The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRTH) has developed the Bidder Information Management System (BIMS) to streamline the process of pre-qualification of bidders for EPC/ HAM and BOT modes of contracts with enhanced transparency and objectivity. BIMS shall work as a database comprising bidder-wise information covering basic details, civil works experience, cash accruals and net worth, annual turnover etc. so that bidder's pre-qualification is quickly assessed based on evaluation parameters like threshold capacity and bid capacity from the already stored data.

2. As per the SOP issued by MoRTH for implementation of Bharatmala Pariyojana program, BIMS shall be used by all the project implementing agencies for maintenance of technical information of civil works of Contractors/ Concessionaires and for on-line technical evaluation of civil works bids.

3. All the prospective Highway Contractors/ Concessionaires engaged by MoRTH/ NHAI/ NHIDCL/ BRO/ State PWDs for implementation of national Highway and other Centrally sponsored works may accordingly be advised to upload their company related details which are necessary to determine their technical eligibility as per the stipulated requirements of model RFP documents of MoRTH issued for EPC/ HAM/ BOT works.

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4. Further, it has been decided that all the national highway contracts shall be procured only through BIMS w.e.f 01.04.2018. All concerned stakeholders may approach Mr. Sanjay Jaju, Director, NHIDCL, if any further/ repeat training is required for hassle-free use of the BIMS.
