04. **Details of training / seminar / workshops organised during the quarter :** B&T Dte organized a 05 day Capsule on “Bridge design analysis using STAAD PRO” from 18 Nov 2019 to 22 Nov 2019 at HQ DGBR for BRO Officers.

05. **Naming of Rohtang Tunnel as “Atal Bihari Vajpayee Tunnel”.** The historic decision to construct a strategic tunnel below the Rohtang Pass was taken on June 3, 2000 when Atal Bihari Vajpayee was the Prime Minister. The 8.8 Km long tunnel is the world’s longest above an altitude on 3,000 metres.

“Rohtang Tunnel has been renamed as “Atal Tunnel” by the Prime Minister on 25 Dec 2019 to honour the contribution of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee.

### **06. Details of Major Bridge inaugurated in the Quarter of Dec 2019.**

(a) **Col Chewang Rinchen, MVC\*, SM Bridge** : The 430 Mtr Col Chewang Rinchen, MVC\*, SM Bridge (10 Spans of 43 Mtr Triple Double Reinforced Extra Wide Bailey Bridge over Micro Pile foundation), on road D-S-DBO under Project Himank in Jammu and Kashmir Region was inaugurated by Shri Rajnath Singh, Hon’ble Raksha Mantri on 21 oct 2019.



(b) **Nurla Bridge** : The 85 Mtr long Nurla Bridge on road Zojila – Kargil – Leh (NH 1) under Project Vijayak in Jammu and Kashmir Region was inaugurated by Shri Jamyang Tsering Namgyal, MP of Ladakh Region on 04 Nov 2019.



(c) **Sisseri Bridge** : The 200 Mtr long Sisseri Bridge on road Ranaghat – Mebo – Dambuk – Bomjir (NH-13) under Project Brahmanik in the state of Arunachal Pradesh was inaugurated by Hon'ble Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh on 15 Nov 2019.

The 200-metre long Sisseri Bridge between Jonai-Pasighat-Ranaghat-Roing roads will ease connectivity between Dibang Valley and Siang to cut down the travel time by about five hours from Pasighat to Roing and reduced 180 km from Dibrugarh. The bridge will play an important role in the overall development and would provide more opportunities in the fields of employment, trade & tourism.



(d) **Punar Bridge**: The 35 Mtr long Punar Bridge on road Joshimath-Malari under project Shivalik in the state of Uttarakhand was inaugurated by Shri TS Rawat, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttarakhand.



(e) **Rabung Bridge**: The 35 Mtr long Rabung Bridge on road Migging-Tuting under project Brahmark in the state of Arunachal Pradesh was inaugurated by Shri Alo Libang, Hon'ble Minister, Health & Family Welfare, Arunachal Pradesh on 26 Dec 2019.



07. **Connectivity of Roads**: The following roads were connected during this period

08. **Traffic on road Manali-Padam-Kargil :** Alternate connectivity to Kargil has been provided through Shinkunla Pass along the newly construction part of Rd Nimu-Padam-Darcha (N-P-D). The existing Padam-Kargil rd has been connected to the N-P-D rd at Padam. Inaugural traffic comprising motor cycle rally movement on the road along Manali-Darcha-Padam-Kargil alignment.

# BRO uses modern technology to build sensitive Ladakh road

The Border Roads Organisation (BRO) has adopted a modern technology, Cementaceous Sub Base (CTSB) — a first-of-its-kind in Asia — for the construction of the sensitive high-altitude Daulat Beg Oldi road bordering China in eastern Ladakh.

According to BRO officials, 12 km of the road is being constructed by utilising the CTSB technology.

The use of the technology is aimed at providing the military with an all-weather road access to north-eastern Ladakh and for facilitating smooth passage of armed personnel and other logistical support.

The area had seen skirmishes during the 1962 India-China conflict and also recent stand-offs. Building this section of the road is a key thrust area of the Defence Ministry for this strategic northernmost corner of India.

"This is a patented technology through which road surface is constructed in an extremely short span of time. The surface is more durable than the one obtained through the conventional method," a senior BRO official said.

He said, "Besides being treacherous, the engineers face multiple challenges in the construction of these roads ranging from extremely high altitude extending to over 19,000 feet above the sea level resulting in acute mountain sickness to workers and rarified oxygen levels."

Crisis-crossing through the

higher Himalayan ranges where temperature dips to below -50°C during the winter, the section offer limited window for executing the works from June to October.

"However, considering the nature of activities required to be undertaken for carving out stable roads in the high seismic zone (seismic-4), conventional methods would take years, much beyond the timelines stipulated for the completion of the projects," the BRO official said.

Under the CTSB technology, a dry admixture is

mixed with sand and crushed stones by means of a machine known as pulveriser. First the crushed stones and sand are spread on the road. The admixture is laid ahead of the pulveriser.

The pulveriser mills over the admixture mixing all the three components, spreading them evenly over the road surface. The surface is watered for some time. The exercise is repeated after a few days to form the second coating. Then the bitumen is laid over the surface as done in the con-

ventional method.

Engineer in charge Feroz Ahmad said, "Through the CTSB technology, the road length will be completed within three months. The same length would have been completed in 2 to 3 years using the conventional method. The road stretch would be more tenacious to withstand harsh climatic conditions prevailing in these terrains."

Chief Engineer, Project Himank, Brig Nitin K Sharma complimented engineers for implementing the new technology in most adverse conditions and said such techniques could be replicated in other border areas where conditions for the construction of the road network was rather impossible.

## Libang inaugurates strategically important Rabung Bridge



**Pasighat, Dec 28 :** Health and Family Welfare Minister Alo Libang on Thursday (Dec 26) inaugurated strategically important "Rabung Bridge" on Migging-Tuting road, constructed by 1448 BCC, 761 BRTF of Project Brahmaputra Border Roads Organisation, Pasighat. Chief Engineer Project Brahmaputra Shri R K Dhiman, VSM was also

present on the occasion. The bridge will facilitate movement of heavy vehicles to Tuting and forward sectors of the region. This bridge is strategically very important for the security force including Indian Army and ITBP as road Migging-Tuting is the only line of communication to border areas and posts located ahead of Tuting near Gelling

and Bishing. This bridge has been constructed with prestressed concrete super structure and reinforced cement concrete foundations with 70 R load capacity. Speaking on the occasion, Minister Libang appreciated 761 BRTF, Project Brahmaputra of BRO for their yeoman services towards development of infrastructure in Arunachal Pradesh and especially far flung and remote areas of Siang valley region. Chief Engineer Project Brahmaputra R K Dhi-

man informed that BRO was progressing double lane work between Nigging to Tuting with high speed and quality and also in the process of finalising proposal of double lane for balance stretches from Migging to Nigging and work would commence soon. Dhiman further informed that BRO would complete another six bridges in Siang and Siyom Valley region shortly which would enhance trafficability in the region to a great extent.



## Army rescues 350 tourists, locals from snow-covered Zojila Pass

Srinagar/Jammu, November 23

About 350 tourists and locals, stranded due to heavy snow, were rescued by the Army from the 11,500-foot high Zojila Pass along the Srinagar-Leh national highway, a defence spokesman said on Friday.

The night-long rescue operation in coordination with civil administration was carried out by Army rescue columns despite continuous snowfall and sub-zero temperature, Srinagar-based defence spokesman Col Rajesh Kalia said in a statement.

Visitors to the area got stuck as regions around the pass like Sonamarg, Baltal and Nilgrar received heavy snow since Thursday which also led to traffic jams at many places, leaving over 250 trucks and passenger vehicles stranded.

Since November 21, he said the vehicles had moved from Sonamarg towards the Zojila Pass but the untimely and heavy snow, especially on the higher reaches, resulted in many vehicles skidding off the road and getting stranded in the snow, causing a traffic jam at many places.

"The traffic jam resulted in a very dangerous situation, wherein approximately 300-350 people, including women and children, were stranded at a height above 11,000 feet and temperature at minus seven degrees.

"In coordination with the civil administration, the Army rescue columns moved in vehicles promptly with aid and administrative assistance to rescue the stranded civilians from the Zojila Pass," he said.

Col Kalia said while the police and GREF personnel got busy with clearing the traffic and snow, respectively, the Army columns started providing immediate medical aid and assistance.

"The stranded vehicles were recovered and organised for moving back. The passengers of the vehicles, which were stuck badly, were evacuated safely back to Sonamarg town in Army vehicles," he said.

He said medical assistance, hot food and blankets were provided for the night by the Army.

"This immediate and pro-active action by the Army was critical in ensuring timely rescue, relief and saving precious lives. The humanitarian assistance provided to the 'Awam' (people) in their hour of need was much appreciated," the officer said.

The Zojila Pass is situated at an altitude of 11,578 feet on the Srinagar-Kargil-Leh National Highway.

## BRO holds musical events to boost morale of jawans

In a bid to perk up the morale of their workforce working in "extremely hazardous" and hostile conditions bereft of even a semblance of entertainment, the Border Roads Organisation (BRO) has embarked upon organising musical events "Call of the mountains" at Ladakh's remote forward areas by renowned film and theatre artistes.

"Discharging duties at an altitude of 18,000 feet above the sea level where oxygen levels are highly rarefied and icy winds blow is very difficult. This result in exposing them to high levels of mental fatigue, besides taking a toll on their physical well-being," the spokesperson said quoting Brig Sharma.

"For addressing health-related issues of jawans, medical facilities have been established at vital installations. This has resulted in dramatic dip in casualties over the past three years," the Chief Engineer said, adding, "It, however, remained a challenge to boost the morale and mental fitness of the jawans. It is with this motive to boost their morale and provide some kind of entertainment to our jawans that we teamed up with Go Magic Trails."

This is the third year in row when the band has been performing at remote forward locations. Recently, they conducted a musical event at Shyok base — almost 130 km north of Leh — and at Daulat Beg Oldies (DBO) forward post, which is situated 350 km away from Leh along with the Indo-China border.

## Min inaugurates strategic bridge between Migging and Tuting

**YINGKIONG**, Health Minister Alo Libang inaugurated Rabung bridge, on the Migging-Tuting road, in Upper Siang district on 26 December.

The bridge was constructed by the Border Roads Organisation's (BRO) 761 BRTF, under Project Brahmark.

The bridge will facilitate movement of heavy vehicles to Tuting and forward sectors of the region. It is also strategically significant for the security forces, including the Indian Army and the ITBP, as the Migging-Tuting road is the only line of communication to the border areas and posts located ahead of Tuting, near Gelling and Bishing.

between Nigging and Tuting with high speed and quality," and that it is also in the process of "finalizing the proposal of double lane for balance stretches from Migging to Nigging," adding that "work will commence soon."

The CE said the BRO would be completing another six bridges in the Siang and Siyom valley region shortly.

It is worth mentioning here that AN-32 aircraft used to drop rations and development materials subject to availability and weather condition which will no more be required.

Expressing his gratitude to BRO for accomplishing the task, Damin block former gram chairperson Bamang Yakap said: "Damin people can now enjoy transport facility to collect their daily necessities without trekking on foot".

Senior BRO officers, when contacted, confirmed their commitment to make the road ahead to Huh trafficable this financial year which involves launching of a 200 feet Bailey bridge over Kumey River near a vertical cliff-face to serve the people of the state.
