Sir,

① I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter F.No.BRDB/03/170/2004/GE-1 dated 24 April 2007 and convey the sanction of the President of India for an increase of 4% in the existing Hardship Allowance of 12% at existing terms for one year with effect from 01st November 2007 to GREF, Army, DAD and ITBP personnel deployed for construction of Road link between Zaranj-Delaram in Afghanistan in accordance with Ministry of External Affairs (FD Section) letter No. Q/FD/6910/11/2005 dated 29 October 2007. After 4% increase, the total Hardship Allowance shall be 16% of Foreign Allowance.

3. The expenditure shall be booked by the CDA (BR) against the Fund deposited by the MEA for construction of Zaranj-Delaram road in Afghanistan.

4. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Defence (Fin/BR) vide their U.O. No. 11(1)/2004/BRS/Vol-I/3314/07 dated 18th December 2007.
