RESPONSIBILITY OF BOARD OF OFFICERS DETAILED BY
COMPETENT AUTHORITIES FOR INSPECTION/AcCEPTANCE OF STORES

1. Instances have come to the notice that the Board of Officers, detailed for inspection/acceptance of stores as per stipulated specifications at Project/TF/unit level, was found to be lacking in discharging their duties in the right perspective leading to the acceptance of inferior quality of stores etc. Thus, the very purpose for which they were detailed was defeated.
2. The UPSC has observed the following while rendering their opinion on the disciplinary cases arose thereby :-

“So far as the culpability for accepting inferior quality stores is concerned, Technical Instruction No 23 clearly states that the Board of Officers are mainly responsible for inspecting the stores and accordingly the Board is primarily responsible for any discrepancy detected even after inspection having been done by them.”
3. The above observation makes it clear that the Board of Officers is fully responsible for any failure in performance of their assigned tasks. Any deviation in compliance of instructions/procedures will be treated as dereliction to assigned duties which would make them liable for disciplinary action. This may specifically be brought to the notice of all officers and staff for their information.
