Subject:-Removal of anomalies arising from the implementation of the revised pay scales and the allowances consequent to the recommendations of the V CPC/HLC - Implementation of pay scales of Major and equivalents.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No.1(26)/97/II/D(Pay/Services) dated 29<sup>th</sup> February, 2000 on the subject mentioned above read with SAI/SNI/SAFI 2/S/98 and to convey the sanction of the President for stepping up of pay of the Officers of the rank of Major and equivalent whose pay on promotion to the rank of Major and equivalent was fixed at Rs.11,600/- in accordance with the aforementioned Army/Navy/Air Force instructions and who are drawing less pay than their juniors consequent on fixation of pay of the juniors on promotion to the rank of Major and equivalent at Rs.11925/- in accordance with the letter dated 29<sup>th</sup> February, 2000. The stepping up will be subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- Both the junior and the senior officers should be of the same rank and should belong to the same cadre/Service;
  - The pre-revised and revised scales of pay of the rank in which they are entitled to draw pay should be identical;
  - If even in the lower rank, the junior Officer was drawing more pay in the pre-revised scale than the senior by virtue of any advance increments granted to him, provision of this letter will not be invoked to step up the pay of the senior officer.



2. The stepping up of pay thus allowed would be further subject to the condition that the anomaly is directly as a result of the application of the provisions of MOD letter No. 1(26)/97/II/D(Fay/Ser) dated 29<sup>th</sup> February, 2000 referred to above.

3. The aforesaid stepping up of pay would be applicable to officers of the rank of Major/equivalent and promoted to the grade during 1.3.1999 to 28.2.2000.

4. This issues with the approval of Defence Secretary and with the concurrence of the Ministry of Defence (Finance) vide their Dy. No.558/AG/PA dated 1.10.2008.
