Online bids are invited on single stage two bid system for **"PROVIDING AND LAYING OF DBM 50 MM THICK, BITUMINOUS CONCRETE 30MM THICK AND ROAD MARKING WITH THERMOPLASTIC PAINTING FOR BALANCE SURFACING WORKS BETWEEN KM 37.900 AND KM 47.850 ON ROAD KAYING – TATO UNDER 92 RCC/44 BRTF IN PROJECT BRAHMANK IN THE STATE OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH" TENDER NO. CE (P) BMK/02/2026-27"**

3. Bids shall be submitted online only at DPP website: <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app> Manual (off line) bids shall not be accepted. Bidders are advised to follow the instructions provided in the **'Instructions to the bidder for the e-submission of the bid online through the Defence Procurement Portal for e-Procurement at https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app'** before proceeding ahead.

4. The work is estimated to cost Rs 351.00 Lakhs (Rupees Three Crore Fifty One Lakh Only) approximately or as subsequently amended in tender documents or uploaded in BRO website www.bro.gov.in and DPP website <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app> This estimate, however, is not a guarantee and is merely given as a rough guide and if works cost more or less, the tenderer shall have no claim on that account of whatsoever nature.

5. The tender shall be based on **General Conditions of Contracts IAFW-2249** incorporating amendments including and upto 49 and **item rate contract form based on IAFW-1779**, special conditions, particular specifications and drawings with schedule 'A' (list of works) to be priced by tenderers.

6. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one contractor or contractors having business relationship. Under no circumstances will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

7. The work is to be completed within **180 days** or subsequently amended in tender documents or uploaded in BRO website www.bro.gov.in and DPP website <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app> on accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender from the date of handing over the site, which will be generally within one month from the date of issue of acceptance letter.

8. The Chief Engineer (P) Brahmark c/o 99 APO will be **Accepting Officer**, here in after, referred to as such for all purposes in this contract.

10. Earnest money is not required to be attached with tender by the valid enlisted contractors with BRO of respective class/Project who have submitted standing security deposit. All other contractor shall deposit EMD alongwith Technical bid for **Rs 4,27,000.00 (Rupees Four Lakh Twenty Seven Thousand Only)** in the shape of call deposit receipt / term deposit receipt/special term deposit receipt in favour of **Chief Engineer Project Brahmanak C/O 99 APO** obtained from any Nationalized/Scheduled bank and having maturity/validity period 90 days more than validity period of his offer. Scanned copy of EMD to be attached with the online bid. **There shall be no exemption on submission of EMD for MSEs for the subject work being Execution contract .**

11. Successful Bidder (L-1) shall deliver to Accepting Officer a Performance Security for an amount of 5% of contract sum in the shape of Bank Guarantee or FDR within 28 days of issue of LOA.

12. Copies of drawings (if applicable) and other documents pertaining to the work (signed for the purpose of identification by the Accepting Officer or his accredited representative) and sample of materials and stores to be supplied by the contractor will be opened for inspection at the following locations:-

15. Any qualification documents/ tender which stipulates any alternative to any of the conditions laid down or which proposes any other conditions of any description whatsoever is liable to be rejected.

The Accepting Officer reserves his right to accept a tender submitted by a Public Undertaking, giving a purchase preference over other tender(s) which may be lower, as are admissible under the Govt policy. No claim for any compensation or otherwise shall be admissible from such tenderers whose tenders may be rejected on account of the said policy.

The submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he had read this notice and conditions of contract and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of the conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plants etc will be issued to him, local conditions and other factors bearing on the execution of the work.

In case of rejection of technical bid, contractor may appeal to next higher Engineering Authority i.e., ADGBR (East) on email bro-hgeast@gov.in with copy to Accepting Officer i.e. Chief Engineer Project Brahman, on email bro-bmk@nic.in against rejection **within 05 days** from the date of publishing of result of Technical Bid qualification on DP Portal whose decision shall be final and binding. If the appeal is not made within this period, the bidder shall forfeit his right of appeal against rejection of his technical bid. Any appeal received after **05 days** of such publication of such result shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

In addition, L-1 tenderer revoking offer and his related firms shall not be allowed to participate in the tender in second or subsequent calls of subject work
