The work is estimated to cost **Rs 190.08 lakh (Rupees One Crore Ninety Lakh Eight Thousand Only)** approximately or as subsequently amended in tender documents or uploaded in BRO website www.bro.gov.in and DPP website <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app> This estimate, however, is not a guarantee and is merely given as a rough guide and if works cost more or less, the tenderer shall have no claim on that account of whatsoever nature.

11. Successful Bidder (L-1) shall deliver to Accepting Officer a Performance Security for an amount of 5% of contract sum in the shape of Bank Guarantee or FDR within 28 days of issue of LOA.

In case of rejection of technical bid, contractor may appeal to next higher Engineering Authority i.e., ADGBR (East) on email bro-hqeast@gov.in with copy to Accepting Officer i.e. Chief Engineer Project Brahman, on email bro-bmk@nic.in against rejection **within 05 days** from the date of publishing of result of Technical Bid qualification on DP Portal whose decision shall be final and binding. If the appeal is not made within this period, the bidder shall forfeit his right of appeal against rejection of his technical bid. Any appeal received after **05 days** of such publication of such result shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

Deptt. and work under other centrally sponsored schemes, for a period of one year from the bid due date of this work. In addition, related firms of L-1 tenderer revoking offer shall not be issued the tender in second or subsequent calls of subject work.
