The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 82.00 Lakhs (Rupees Eighty Two Lakh Thousand only)** approximately or as subsequently amended in tender documents or uploaded in BRO web site <a href="www.bro.gov.in">www.bro.gov.in</a> and DPP website <a href="https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app">https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app</a>. Under no circumstances will a father or his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

The work is to be completed within 12 months (365 days) or as subsequently amended in tender documents or uploaded in BRO web site <a href="www.bro.gov.in">www.bro.gov.in</a> and DPP website <a href="https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app">https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app</a> in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender from the date of handing over the site, which will be generally within one month from the date of issue of acceptance letter.

Bid Securing Declaration as per Rule 170 (iii) of GFR 2017 is required to attach by the firm registered with MSME, MSE in lieu of EMD as per format attached at page No 231 of Tender Documents.
- 11. Successful Bidder (L-1) shall deliver to Accepting Officer a Performance Security for an amount of 5% of contract sum in the shape of Bank Guarantee or FDR within 28 days of issue of LoA.

The Accepting Officer reserves his right to accept a tender submitted by a Public Undertaking, giving a purchase preference over other tender (s) which may be lower, as are admissible under the Government Policy. No claim for any compensation or otherwise shall be admissible from such tenderers whose tenders may be rejected on account of the said policy.
- 17. The submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he had read this notice and conditions of contract and has made himself fully aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of the conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plants etc will be issued to him, local conditions and other factors bearing on the execution of the work.

- 26. In the event of lowest tenderer revoking his offer or revising his rates upward (which will be treated as revocation of offer), after opening of tenders, the earnest money deposited by him shall be forfeited.
